

First Sustainability Report



Prof. Raj Kumar Mittal the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Chaudhary Bansi Lal University, Bhiwani presented the first Sustainability Report of the University to Hon'ble Governor -Chancellor of Haryana Shri Bandaru Dattatreya ji at Raj Bhawan, Haryana Chandigarh. Report is an attempt to map the initiatives which University has taken to align it's teaching -learning activities with 17 SDGs aimed at making world prosperous, liveable, inclusive and peaceful. Prof. Mittal pointed out that report shall help in sensitising the stakeholders especially students and staff to contribute towards the attainments of SDGs. Few initiatives worth to mention include; harnessing of solar energy in new campus (around 80 percent of energy needs are met through solar power), bhumi suposhan programme to make soil chemical free in Bhiwani district, water conservation programme, promoting sustainable consumption behaviour in Bhiwani city, promoting entrepreneurship especially among the women through organising fairs of Swadeshi products and workshops, 15 hobby clubs to allow students to pursue activities of their interest and prepare them to ultimately explore the possibility of converting passion into profession, directing research to solve local problems of people. University is working hard to change the mindset of students from job seekers to job providers and pursue self employment and entrepreneurship as their career. Students are being promoted to earn while they learn in the campus. We at CBLU believe that through quality education and holistic development of students SDGs can be better achieved at a faster speed. As our understanding improves through this excercise so will improve the alignment of SDGs with the curriculum of CBLU and the University's contribution in achievement of SDGs.

19th convocation of Adarsh Mahila College, Bhiwani

He asked young graduating students to value and strengthen Indian family system and do not be swayed by western culture and values. Lastly Hon'ble Vice chancellor, asked students to put their best to make Bharat Viksit by 2047.

RESURGENT BHARAT ON THE GLOBAL CANVAS



Prof. Raj Kumar Mittal, Hon' ble Vice Chancellor, attended the two days international conference on the theme RESURGENT BHARAT ON THE GLOBAL CANVAS at Dr. Ambedkar International Centre, Delhi from Feburary 25-26, 2024. Speaking in the valedictory ceremony Prof.Mittal thanked ABRSM, the organisers for giving the opportunity to CBLU, Bhiwani to be part of this and previously three international conferences organised in Delhi. Speaking on the occassion Prof. Mittal emphasised on the following:

- 1. Vikshit Bharat means lifting the size of our economy to 35-40 trillion dollar, 10 times the present size of GDP; building employment centric economy; socially and economically inclusive economy; and environmentally sustainable economy.
- 2. Two factors presently shaping the education include; technology and western thoughts and values . He pointed out that Bharat already has missed out earlier three industrial revolutions and hardly can afford the fourth based on 4.0 technologies focusing on AI and automation. Technology is here to stay and shall play crucial role in making Bharat a Vikshit Bharat. Educational institutions have to sensitise the students to embrace these emerging technologies and start skill updating programmes. Western thoughts and values are adversely affecting the thinking and living of our youth including the family values. The 37 crores of our youth in the age group of 15-29 years needs to be nurtured and educated on Panchakosh based education focusing on Annamaya, Prannmaya, Mannomaya, Vigyaanmaya and Anandmaya koshas . Prof Mittal also stressed on making faculty and students aware about local people, resources, knowhow and problems and direct their energy and mindset in addressing the issues and problems local people are facing thus making Bharat Aatmanirbhar. The path to Vikshit Bharat can be through Self employment and entrepreneurship promotion. Educational institutions have to develop eco -system and provide platforms for students to hone their skills and become Swavalambi Yuva to make Bharat a Vikshit Bharat.

Sports Education



Under effecient guidance of Chaudhary Bansi Lal University Vice-Chancellor Prof. Raj Kumar Mittal and Registrar Dr. Reetu Singh formulation of various activities like Sports, Cultural, Education & Research and also setting new records in entrepreneurship.
